In addition, there are some extra blank grids in the back, as well as a line guide to help you follow the grids, along with black and white solutions, but try not to peek. Vol. 1 (older kids' small-grid version) has 20 designs, and Vol. 2 (younger kids' large-grid version) has 22 designs. Together, they provide fun for the entire family.
